What's going on?


Yoga

Thank you to Susan Morrow for designing and printing our amazing jumpers and t-shirts. They look incredibly smart and the children love them.








Grant from Gardiner Foundation


Grant from Fonterra



Lunch Box



Ham and Egg Pies



Ingredients

- oil spray
- 3 large slices lean ham (75g)
- 4 eggs, lightly beaten
- 2 tbsp milk
- 3 spring onions (shallots), finely chopped
- 1/2 cup canned creamed corn or corn kernels
- 1 tbsp chopped basil
- 1/2 cup (40g) grated low fat tasty cheese
- salt and pepper

Method

Step 1: Heat oven to 200°C (180°C fanforced) and spray 6 cups of a muffin tray. Line each cup with ham and set aside.

Step 2: Whisk eggs with milk, spring onions, corn, basil and grated cheese. Season with salt and pepper.

Step 3: Divide mixture among the 6 cups and bake for 25-30 minutes until pies are set in the middle.

Step 4: Remove from oven, run a blunt knife around the edge to loosen and allow pies to sit in the tray for 5 minutes.

Step 5: Remove pies from the muffin tray and enjoy with a salad.


